INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Open to Amateurs who are male members of a recognized KZNGU Club affiliated to the KZNGU who, at the time of the closing of entries shall have a COMBINED HANDICAP assessed under the S.A. Golf Association Course Rating and Handicapping system of EIGHT or less. The handicap qualifying for the entry to the event will be that declared in the entry form.
2. 36 Holes – Better Ball Medal from scratch on SUNDAY, 26th February 2012.
3. An entrance fee of **R400-00 PER PLAYER** is payable to the KZNGU and must be in their hands together with an Entry Form – fully completed by **12 noon on FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 17th 2012**. Late entries will not be accepted and on no account will entry fees be refunded unless an entry is withdrawn prior to the closing date of entries. Faxed entries to the KZNGU (Fax No. 031-2021022 or 086-5709222) will be accepted provided faxed copy of the entry form is accompanied by a deposit slip evidencing payment to the union's Account with:

4. All entries shall be subject to the approval of the KZNGU Executive, which reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving any reason for such refusal. The decision of the Executive as to acceptance or refusal of any entry shall be final. The Executive may, in its discretion, limit the number of entries.
5. Players shall start at the time laid down by the Committee (Rule 6-3(a)). The penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole in stroke-play.
6. Times of play, disputes and all other arrangements connected with the championship and competition shall be decided by the Executive of the KZNGU, which has power to alter the programme at its discretion. The KZNGU reserves the right to change the venue to another course for the event either in part or entirely, in the case of exceptional circumstances and also reserves the right to alter the advertised times of starting.
7. (a) **If the COMPETITOR HAS THE SERVICES OF A CADDIE, SUCH CADDIE MUST BE HIRED FROM THE CLUB- CADDIE OFFICE.**
(b) **Competitors MAY ride motorized carts. Competitors MAY NOT make use of rangefinders.**
8. Competitors may only use those golf balls and driving clubs appearing in the current list of conforming golf balls and drivers, and must ensure that the grooves of their clubs meet the specifications in Appendix o11 of the rules of golf.
9. Dress regulations on the course, as set by the Host Club must be strictly adhered to. Camouflage type pants are not acceptable. Socks should be white athletic.
10. **Exemption of Liability:**
The Host Club, Union and their management will not be held responsible for any damages, loss, including personal loss and or other forms of loss, harm or injury sustained as stipulated below:
The Host Club and Union will not be held liable for any of the following:
 - 1.1 Physical and/or emotional injuries suffered during the tournament/championship, due to any acts of God, suffered as a direct result thereof, including aspects such as being struck by lightning, etc.
 - 1.2 Physical injuries of any kind suffered by any person, including a player or spectator sustained by own negligence, or otherwise.
 - 1.3 Emotional injuries sustained due to any loss, including death, suffered as a result of any of the above injuries sustained personally or by a spectator.
 - 1.4 Damages suffered to any property of a player.The player acknowledges the exemption of liability of the Union and it's management as listed above when he submits the entry form.
The Host Club and Union does not warrant or guarantee the safety of any person.
11. Outside caddies are **NOT** permitted. However, concessions could be made "on the day" if a shortage of caddies occurs.
12. **Anti-Doping Policy**
All competitors are subject to the provisions of the International Golf Federation's Anti-Doping Policy. Details of the Policy and the current Prohibited Substances and methods, are available from the International Golf Federation's website (www.internationalgolfederation.org).
Competitors who are taking medication and in doubt as to their clinical status should seek advice from the South African Golf Association not later than 30 days before the start of the tournament. **Random testing may take place.**
