CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND INFORMATION

1. The entry will be restricted to 104 players. If, FOR ANY REASON YOU CANNOT PLAY **PLEASE IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY THE KWAZULU-NATAL GOLF UNION TO SCRATCH YOU FROM THE DRAW.**
2. Entries will only be accepted from Amateur players with Club Handicaps of 24 or less; who are under the age of 18 years on April 3rd, 2012; who are members of a Club affiliated to the KwaZulu-Natal Golf Union, where handicaps are assessed under the South African Golf Association Course Rating and Handicapping System. The Handicap recorded by the player on the signed Entry Form will be the Handicap for the event.
3. The competition will be an 18 hole Medal event, on handicap, played under the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and the Bye-Laws and Local Rules of the Host Club, as approved and amended by the KZNGU. The winner of the "Best Nett" event receives the Prentice Memorial Trophy. Prizes to 1.2.3 nett and 1.2. gross.
4. Times of play, disputes and all arrangements connected with the competition shall be decided by the Executive of the KZNGU which has the power to alter the programme at its discretion. The KZNGU reserves the right, in the case of exceptional circumstances, to change the venue to another course for the event, either in part or entirely, and also reserve the right to alter the advertised starting times. Players shall start at the time laid down by the Committee (Rule 6-3(a)). The penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole. Disqualification after 5 minutes. In addition the pace of play will be monitored and slow play can be penalized. (See Local Rules issued for this event).
5. Parents or near relatives **MAY NOT** caddie for the entrant.
6. All Entry Forms must be **FULLY AND PROPERLY COMPLETED** with all the information requested thereon and sent to the Secretary, KWAZULU-NATAL GOLF UNION, PostNet Suite No 166, Private Bag X04, Dalbridge, 4014 or 77 Bulwer Road, Glenwood, Durban, 4001 or can be faxed to the Union on 031-2021022/0865 70922 or e-mailed to lindy@kzngolf.co.za to arrive by 12 noon on Tuesday, 20th March, 2012
7. Dress Regulations on the course as set by the Host Club must be strictly adhered to. Socks should be white athletic.
8. **EXEMPTION OF LIABILITY:**
The Host Club, Union and their management will not be held responsible for any damages, loss, including personal loss and or other forms of loss, harm or injury sustained as stipulated below: The Host Club and Union will not be held liable for any of the following:
 - 1.1 Physical and/or emotional injuries suffered during the tournament/championship, due to any acts of God, suffered as a direct result thereof, including aspects such as being struck by lightning, etc.
 - 1.2 Physical injuries of any kind suffered by any person, including a player or spectator sustained by own negligence, or otherwise.
 - 1.3 Emotional injuries sustained due to any loss, including death, suffered as a result of any of the above injuries sustained personally or by a spectator.
 - 1.4 Damages suffered to any property of a player.The player acknowledges the exemption of liability of the Union and it's management as listed above when he signs the acknowledgement also acknowledges the contents of the above, understands it, and exempt the Host Club and Union from any liability as indicated above. The Host Club and Union does not warrant or guarantee the safety of any person.
9. **Outside caddies** are **NOT** permitted. However, concessions could be made "on the day" if a shortage of caddies occurs.
10. **ANTI-DOPING POLICY:** All competitors are subject to the provisions of the International Golf Federation's Anti-Doping Policy. Details of the Policy and the current Prohibited Substances and methods, are available from the International golf Federation's website (www.internationalgolfederation.org). Competitors who are taking medication and in doubt as to their clinical status should seek advice from the South African Golf Association not later than 30 days before the start of the tournament.
Random testing may take place.
